Our History

The Baltimore Area N-TRAK Club (BANTRAK) is a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to promoting the hobby of model railroading. BANTRAK was founded in Baltimore County in 1983, under the name The Greater Baltimore N-Scale Associates (GBNSA). The club began as a local “round robin” group of N-Scale enthusiasts who met once a month in a Club member’s home. While we have retained this original structure to a large degree, over the years we have expanded our focus to include participation in many diverse activities including shows, meets and conventions, both locally and nationally.

Though we started as an N-Trak club, we have added Free-moN and have developed a large T-Trak component. Our membership has greatly expanded with current members residing in Baltimore City, the surrounding counties, and the Washington, D.C., suburbs, as well as in Pennsylvania and Virginia.



N-Scale Modeling

The BANTRAK club and many of our individual members have received local, regional and national recognition for their modeling skills and their continued contributions to model railroading. We have members of all ages experienced in model building, electronics, carpentry and other aspects of this hobby. We are always interested in sharing our experiences and learning from others, while we all enjoy N-Scale model railroading.



Membership

Membership is open to all persons over 18 years old who are interested in the hobby of N-Scale model railroading. Those under 18 may join with a participating parent. Meetings are held the third Sunday of each month from 2-5 pm. Annual dues are \$45 per person. Each member receives a monthly newsletter that contains reports of club events, happenings in the model railroad community and articles contributed by individual members. A portion of the dues is for your membership in the *NTRAK* organization. A periodic *NTRAK* newsletter is included as a membership benefit.
